President's Patter

Apologies for a Newsletter a few days later this month and a little shorter than usual – not sure just where the month of June went!!!

All eyes and ears these past few days have been centred on Orlando and our 62nd Zonta International Convention. The daily Convention Newsletter is distributed by email and also posted on Facebook so hopefully most of you have access to it – it is good reading and the photos are wonderful to see. Our District has featured in the displays and videos and been recognised with

an award going to the Brisbane Metro Breakfast Club for the Zonta Says No Walk last November. District 23 also received an award for the Zonta Birthing Kits project which is a project supported by many of our District 22 Clubs. As I write this, the elections have been held and our new International leadership elected. They will take office from the close of Convention as will our own new District Governor – Judith Trevan-Hawke and our new District Board – our Area 3 Director will be Anne Kuhnemann from the Brisbane River Club. Our congratulations go to all, along with our best wishes for this coming Biennium.

Other news from Convention is that Zonta is now in 67 countries worldwide and our international members number over 30,540 – an increase on the last biennium. Zontians throughout the world gave \$US5.1 million to the Foundation last biennium and to date for the current Biennium ie since I June 2014, some \$US90,000 has been donated.

As I write this, delegates are debating the many proposed changes to ZI Bylaws and on the proposed International Service projects for the coming biennium. Denise will report on these at our July Meeting.

Our Guest Speaker at our June Meeting was Kristy Fitzgerald, the Senior Social Worker from the Sexual Assault Response Team based at Logan Hospital but servicing all of the Brisbane area. This is one of the organisations our Club decided to support this year by the allocation of dollars to purchase required clothing for users of the service. Kristy outlined her role and the Unit's work in the support of men and women who have reported sexual assault and sought assistance. The Unit supports a large geographical area and works on an outreach model. She said a forensic clinic has recently been opened at Logan Hospital whereas previously all cases were handled at the Royal Brisbane Hospital. She said that the donation of clothing as approved by our members would be a great asset for the services of the Clinic in supporting women assisted by the Clinic.


