

Recipes

Maple Mustard Salmon

Ingredients

4 fresh salmon portions, skin on

2 Tbsp wholegrain mustard

1/2 cup maple syrup

8 kipfler potatoes peeled

1 Tbsp oil

Green beans, steam to serve

4 lemon wedges, to serve

Method

Pre heat oven to 2200c. Place potatoes into a saucepan and cover with cold water, bring to boil and cook until tender 10-12 minutes. Cut in half and coat in oil, bake potatoes in the oven for 15 minutes until golden, turning occasionally. Combine wholegrain mustard and maple syrup in a bowl, and then coat the salmon portions. Place salmon portions on lined oven try. Bake salmon with the potatoes for 8/10 minutes. Serve hot with cooked potatoes, green beans and lemon wedges to garnish.

Decadent Hot & Cold Chocolate

Ingredients

2/3 cup pouring cream50 g finely chopped dark chocolate30 ml Frangelico or Amaretto LiqueurGood quality Chocolate ice-cream

Method

In a small saucepan add pouring cream and dark chocolate, stir for 3 minutes or until smooth, over a medium heat. Pour Frangelico or Amaretto liqueur into a glass. Top with chocolate mixture and scoops of chocolate ice cream.
